GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Schools must register online at www.technolympicscsn.net latest by Saturday, 22nd August, 2020 by 11:59 PM with student's ID card containing photo
- **Participants must join our Discord Server (Discord link on our website) at least 48 hours before their respective prelims.**
- Any changes must be notified beforehand at the registration channel on the Discord Server at least 48 hours before the respective prelims
- Preliminary rounds of some of the events will be based on online submissions. **All the submissions should be mailed to their event's respective email IDs latest by Monday, 24th August, 2020**
- Results of the online prelims will be declared on the official website i.e. www.technolympicscsn.net on Thursday, 27th August 2020
- Participants must join our Discord server with their full name as Discord Username
- No student can participate in more than one event except in case of 'Cryptic Hunt'
- Only one team from each school can participate in an event except in case of 'Cryptic Hunt' event
- The host school will not participate in any of the events
- Participants will be asked to turn on their camera during the event

- Please ensure that the students have stable Internet connection. Host school is not responsible for any glitches from student's end
- The opening and closing ceremony will be conducted on 31st August 2020 in respective time slots and results will be declared in the closing ceremony

Eligible Classes: IX-XII

Number of Participants: 01

Prelims:

- Prepare a poster on the topic:
"80's Music Concert"
- Send the link (Google Drive, Dropbox, etc.) of the .psd file to photoshop2020.csn@gmail.com before 24th August 2020
- Participants can use external brushes but link to the brushes should be provided in the word file
- Minimum version: Photoshop CS6

Finals:

- Topics will be provided on the spot
- A Google Drive link would be provided for pictures and other materials
- Use of only Google Drive Link is allowed
- Minimum version: Photoshop CS6

Glissando

Eligible Classes: IX-XII

Number of Participants: 02

Prelims:

- Participants will have to create a remix of a song by remixing the stems which will be provided
- Please ensure that the software (FL Studio or Ableton Live) are pre-installed in the participant's PC/Laptop
- Students will have to submit the project file and the track in .wav format before **24th August 2020** on [**glissandocsn@gmail.com**](mailto:glissandocsn@gmail.com)
- Top 8 teams would be qualified for the finals

Finals:

- Finalists would be provided with a stem to remix
- Minimum time allotted for the duration of the remix is 2-minutes 30 seconds or the entire duration of the stem provided
- External Audio Files/ Plugins are not allowed



Battle of Brains

Eligible Classes: IX-XII

Number of Participants: 02

- **The preliminary round of the quiz will be conducted on Discord**
- **Participants are also requested to keep ready any necessary application that may be required to create a Word file**
- 6 teams will advance to the final round which would be conducted on **AhaSlides.com**
- You might be asked to share your screen anytime during the quiz by the quizmaster
- **Any use of unfair means would lead to disqualification of the respective team during the prelims**
- Time will be a major factor during the Quiz
- The decision of the quizmaster will be final and binding



Synclets

Eligible Classes: IX-XII

Number of Participants: 01

First 30 teams to register will be selected for prelims. The names of qualified teams will be disclosed on our Discord Server.

Game: Valorant

- Participants are requested to have Valorant pre-installed and a good internet connection on their respective devices
- Participants are also required to join our Discord Server
- Prelims would be multiple Deathmatch rounds depending upon the number of players participating, among which the top 4 fraggers would advance to the semi-finals
- In case of equal kills, K/D would be taken into consideration of the clashing fraggers
- Anyone using unfair means would be disqualified.
- List of the Participants Qualified for the next round will be disclosed on Discord
- Rules for the semi-final and finals would be disclosed on the spot

Eligible Classes: VI-VIII

Number of Participants: 02

Prelims:

- Participants are required to send their entries on slidesiege.csn@gmail.com before **24th August 2020**
- The presentation has to be on the topic:
"Classroom Of Tomorrow / Data Security In India"
- The presentation must contain 7-8 slides and can be made using any software
- Selection will be based upon information, colour scheme/theme, graphics and tools used

Finals:

- Finalists will join our Discord server to compete
- Topic of the presentation will be given on the spot
- **The presentation must contain 14-15 slides and can be made using any software**
- After making the presentation, the participants have to present it in 6-7 minutes
- One student will handle the presentation while the other would present/describe their work



Poster Making

Eligible Classes: VI-VIII

Number of Participants: 01

Prelims:

- Participants have to make a poster using any software on the **Topics:**
 - "Mental well-being"
 - "Sustainability"
 - "Gender equality"
- The entries must be submitted them before 24th August, 2020 on **technolympics20.2.0@gmail.com**
- Participants can use any software of their choice but need to mention the same at the time of submission

Finals:

- Top 6 teams would be selected for the final round which will be held on Discord
- Topics will be given on the spot
- Participants will have to give brief explanation of all the tools used by them for making the poster



Pyrocrypt

Eligible Classes: XI-XII

Number of Participants: 01

Language: Python 3

Python interpreter requirement- 3.8 - 3.8.3

Prelims:

- Preliminary round will be conducted online via website (website will be revealed during the prelims round) on **23rd August, 2020 from 4:30 PM to 8 PM**
- Participation must be individual, any Team or Truce is not allowed
- In case of doubts regarding credibility of submission, participants might be subjected to viva
- Judgement will be based on grasp on logic, error detection or debugging skills, overall coding and time efficiency
- Only 5 submissions will be selected for finals and decisions taken during the competition will be final



Pyrocrypt

Finals :

- **Finals will be a 3 round based** competition among the 5 selected participant
- **No extra time will be provided**
- **Participants can be asked to explain their approach to code at any moment.**
- No custom IDEs can be used during the event



ThinkTank

Eligible Classes: OPEN

Number of Participants: 01

- The event will be held in two rounds:
Prelims and Finals
- Topics for the same will be given on the spot
- Both rounds will begin with each speaker getting one minute to specify their stance on the topic, which will be followed by a discussion among all the participants
- Shortlisted participants will be promoted to the Finals
- Judgement will be based on the basis of communication skills, content, interaction, fluency, relevance and overall conduct



Meshmerize

Eligible Classes: IX-XII

Number of Participants: 02

- Participants have to create a movie on the topic, **"Indomitable Spirit "or "Cinematic B-Rolls in Lockdown",** and mail at editorsnutshell@gmail.com by **24th August 2020**
- 6 films will be selected for the final judgement and screening
- Any software can be used to create the movie
- Profanity/any form of abuse/bullying (etc.) in the video(s) is not allowed
- **Duration: 4-5 minutes**
- The short films may be in their original language, but **MUST** be subtitled in ENGLISH. Films submitted previously to any other festival will not be considered for this contest
- Gameplays and templates are not allowed in the video while Stock footage can be used (with copyrights)
- **COPYRIGHT: The Film must not contain any copyrighted work(s) belonging to third parties unless participants have a license to use such works in the Film**
- Judgement will be based on filming, editing, music syncing and presentation



Cryptic Hunt

Eligible Classes: OPEN

Number of Participants: OPEN

- Participants will have to use the given hints to clear levels and find the answers to proceed to next levels
- Participants can be questioned on how they found the answer at any point during the event
- Participants found using unfair means, making truces or/and disclosing answers will be immediately disqualified
- The winner will be decided on the basis of the number of levels he/she has cleared and in case of a tie, there will be a tie breaker question which will be time based



Word.net

Eligible Classes: VI-VIII

Number of Participants: 01

- The topic for the Crossword will be **"Technological Terms and Recent Technological Developments"**
- The event will be held on Google Sheets, all participants must have a Google account and the email ID must be shared with the event in-charge at least a day before the competition
- It is highly recommended for the participant to use a PC instead of a mobile device
- Selection criteria for the finals is going to be marks scored
In case of clashing scores, the time taken to finish the crossword by the clashing participants would be taken into consideration
- The prelims will have the same crossword for all participants and the finals will have different crosswords based on specific topics (related to technology) for each participant
